- ✓ RFI has placed 147 dogs in over 19 states.
- ✓ RFI places Service Dogs nationwide, at absolutely no cost to Veterans with disabilities and children with autism.

- ✓ The average cost to train and place a Service Dog is \$30,000 or more across the Service Dog industry.

Full Training Sponsorship | \$30,000

This supports the entire two years of intensive training for each dog in our program, including the final stage when clients are trained and matched with their Service Dog. When possible, Full Training Sponsors have the opportunity to meet their sponsored Service Dog team.



Kennel Sponsorship | \$15,000

These donations help maintain our Iowa and Missouri facilities, where our dogs learn to perform advanced tasks that mitigate our clients' physical and/or psychiatric disabilities. Sponsors are recognized with permanent signage over one of our kennels, and have the opportunity to privately tour the facility.



Final Placement Sponsorship | \$10,000

This sponsorship supports the final stage of a dog's training. In this stage, the RFI team works individually with clients to find the perfect Service Dog match. RFI conducts regular follow-ups throughout the life of the Service Dog team. When possible, supporters at this level have the opportunity to meet their sponsored Service Dog team.
